

Future U - Your vision for a new New Zealand

Entry Terms and Conditions

The following entry terms and conditions apply to the Future U video competition. The organisers reserve the right to disqualify any individual that violates these terms and conditions or the intended spirit of the competition. For special circumstances, eligibility is subject to individual review.

1. The competition is open to New Zealand based students aged between 13 and 18 years of age as at 31 December 2012.
2. The competition is organised by Massey University, New Zealand (“Massey”) via its External Relations Team, Private Bag 11222, Palmerston North.
3. By registering his/her details as part of the competition entrants agree to be bound by these terms (“the Terms”).
4. The competition commences at 9am, Monday 30 July 2012; and video submissions can be received up until 5pm, Sunday 26 August 2012.
5. Entrants under 16 years of age must obtain parental or guardian permission before entering.
6. Video submissions should be no more than two minutes in length; if longer the entrant may be disqualified.
7. Video submission must be uploaded in the specified format.
8. Only one submission per person will be accepted.
9. Videos will be screened before being loaded on the website; any video containing racist, discriminatory or profane language, gang insignia, etc. will automatically be disqualified, and may be referred to authorities.
10. On entry, all entrants who make finalist status agree to attend the thought leadership workshop, and be available for the new NZ Symposium in Auckland should they become the winner.
11. The judges’ decision will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
12. The winner will be selected on Thursday 11 October 2012, unless advised otherwise.
13. The winner takes the prize entirely at his/her own risk, and indemnifies Massey in respect of any claim for any accident, injury, property damage or loss that may occur in connection with the prize.
14. The prizes are as set out on the Future U website – www.engine.ac.nz/future-u.
15. Prizes are neither transferable nor redeemable for cash.
16. Massey has the right to select an alternative winner in the event that Massey has reasonable grounds for believing that a selected winner has breached any of the Terms.
17. Prizes are neither transferable nor redeemable for cash.
18. An entrant’s video must be his/her own, original creation, and must not infringe any third party rights; eg. through the use of someone else’s music, video or images.

19. By entering the competition, entrants agree that Massey and its affiliates and licensees will have the exclusive right to use his/her video for promotional purposes for as long as deemed necessary by Massey, including in any media, for no payment or other compensation. The entrant assigns to Massey all intellectual property rights (including copyright) in the entry submitted.
20. Entry into the competition will be deemed acceptance of the Terms, and is deemed approval to use the winners' name(s) and photograph(s) for publicity purposes.
21. Massey may at its discretion refuse to award any prize to any entrant who fails to comply with the Terms.
22. This competition is not open to Massey University staff and their immediate families.
23. Information on how to enter forms part of the Terms. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of the Terms.

Privacy

Massey is committed to ensuring entrants' privacy is protected. Massey will only use and store an entrant's personal information for the purposes disclosed to him/her, including sharing it with any other organisation that helps Massey provide goods or services to the entrant; eg. delivering a prize to a winner). The information an entrant provides when entering the competition via the web portal will only be used in accordance with privacy laws. In order to prevent unauthorised access, Massey has put in place security procedures to safeguard entrants' personal information.

An entrant will only receive marketing material from Massey if he/she checks the appropriate box on the entry form.
